Project Story (from UVLT archives)

Bob and Jean Keene took the lead in conserving land in an area of Hanover Center identified by Hanover's Open Space Priorities Plan as having high conservation value. From its frontage on Dogford Road, the Keene's 113-acres rise almost to the crest of Lord's Hill, taking in mixed hardwood forest, stands of white pine, a large open field, wetlands, and several tributaries of Monahan Brook. The diversity of cover provides abundant wildlife habitat. Moose, bear, deer, fox, raccoon, coyote, a rich variety of songbirds, pileated woodpeckers, and many kinds of hawks and owls breed here.
