In 2017, with an eye towards protecting and enhancing this environment, the Lake Morey Foundation joined with UVLT to protect the 148 acres that today encompasses Morey Mountain Conservation Area. In June of 2018, they gave the land to UVLT to own and manage for conservation stewardship as the Morey Mountain Conservation Area.

The property lies near another UVLT-owned property - Cliff's Cliff at the Palisades - and is within a larger area identified as a "hot spot" by the VT agency of Natural Resources due to an abundance of rare, endangered, or threatened species.

The property includes portions of a natural community, Hemlock-Sphagnum Acidic Basin Swamp, considered rare in the State of Vermont, and contains vascular plants considered rare or extremely rare in the state. The eastern portion of the property buffers an active nesting area for peregrine falcons, making careful management of this area of critical importance to the success of the birds.
