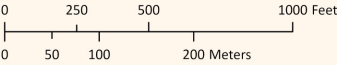
## Upper Valley Land Trust

Located at the northern edge of a large unfragmented forest area, the Ely Mountain Conservation Area is open to the public for hiking, snowshoeing, skiing, and hunting. Here, you will find huge old trees, rock outcroppings, glacial boulders, seeps, wetlands, and a variety of wildlife habitats.

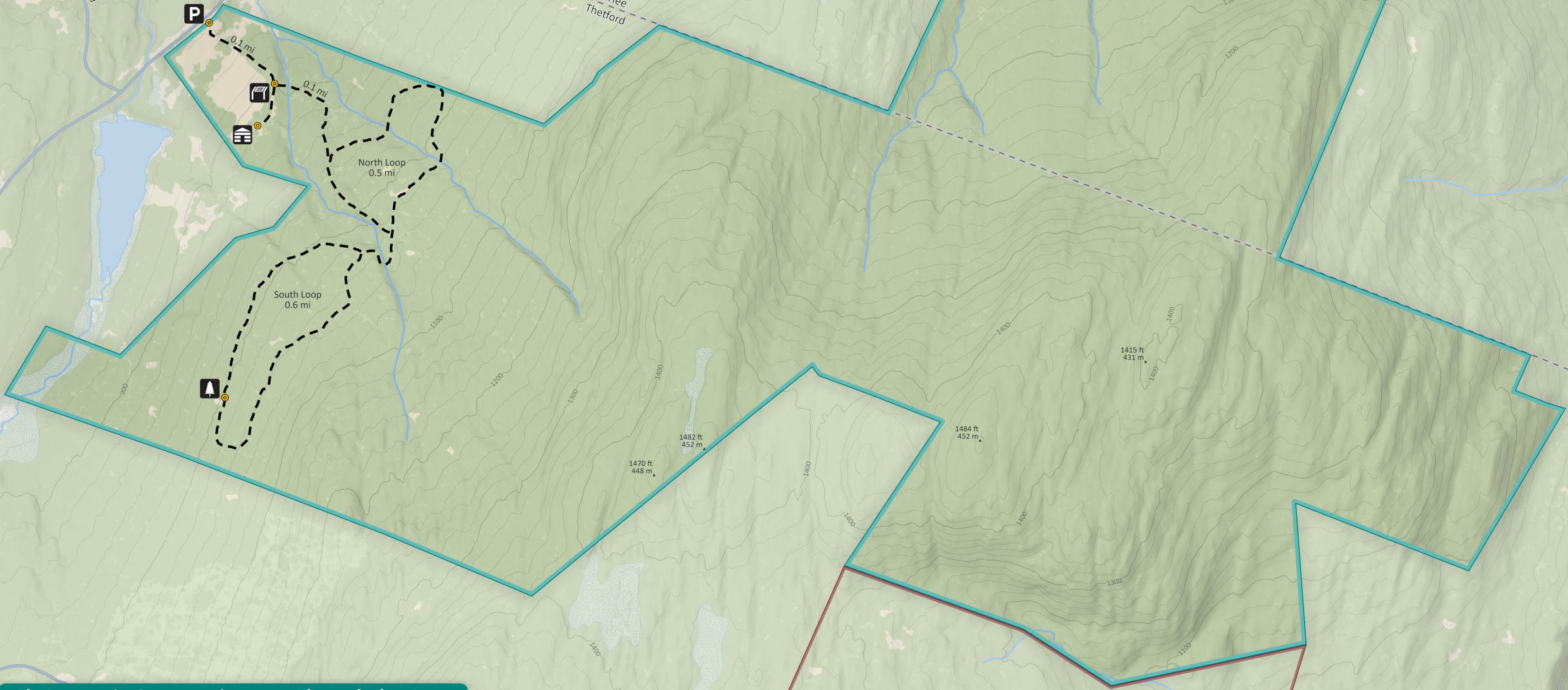

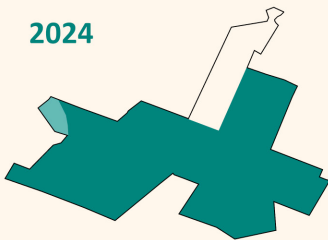
